



**Write the word Articles if the item is found in the Articles of Confederation. If the Constitution is described, write Constitution. No answer is repeated within each topic.**

**1) Legislature**

\_\_\_\_\_ : Bicameral, called Congress, divided into the House of Representatives and the Senate.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Unicameral, called Congress.

**2) Members of Congress**

\_\_\_\_\_ : Between two and seven members per state.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Two Senators per state, Representatives apportioned according to population of each state.

**3) Voting in Congress**

\_\_\_\_\_ : One vote per Representative or Senator.

\_\_\_\_\_ : One vote per state.

**4) Appointment of members**

\_\_\_\_\_ : All appointed by state legislatures, in the manner each legislature directed.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Representatives elected by popular vote, Senators appointed by state legislatures.

**5) Term of legislative office**

\_\_\_\_\_ : Two years for Representatives, six for Senators.

\_\_\_\_\_ : One year.

**6) Congressional Pay**

\_\_\_\_\_ : Paid by the federal government.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Paid by states.

**7) Chair of legislature**

\_\_\_\_\_ : Speaker of the House of Representatives, Vice President is President of the Senate.

\_\_\_\_\_ : President of Congress.

8) Executive: \_\_\_\_\_: None \_\_\_\_\_: President

9) National Judiciary

\_\_\_\_\_ : Maritime judiciary established.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Federal judiciary established, including Supreme Court.

10) Who settles disputes between states?

\_\_\_\_\_ : Supreme Court.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Congress.

11) New States

\_\_\_\_\_ : Admitted upon agreement of nine states (special exemption provided for Canada).

\_\_\_\_\_ : Admitted upon agreement of Congress.

12) Amendment

\_\_\_\_\_ : When agreed upon by all states.

\_\_\_\_\_ : When agreed upon by three-fourths of all states.

13) Armed forces

\_\_\_\_\_ : Congress authorized to build a navy; states authorized to equip warships. to counter piracy; Congress to decide on size of force and to requisition troops from each state according to population.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Congress authorized to build a navy; states not allowed to keep ships of war; Congress authorized to raise and support armies.

14 Power to coin money and Taxation

\_\_\_\_\_ : United States and the states; taxes apportioned by Congress, collected by the states.

\_\_\_\_\_ : United States only; taxes laid and collected by Congress.

15) Ratification

\_\_\_\_\_ : Unanimous consent required.

\_\_\_\_\_ : Consent of nine states required.
